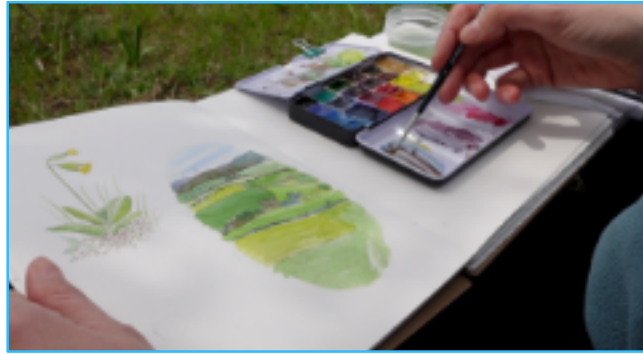


Tools + materials

I like to use flexible and lightweight tools, so graphite and watercolor works great for me. Throw in a few colored pencils, a fountain pen and one or two acrylic markers, and I'm all set. I like to have a kit that lets me start my painting within a minute of stopping and setting up.



Suggested materials:

- Sketchbook with cotton paper, or other watercolor-friendly options
 - Compact watercolor palette (see next page for pigment options)
 - painting rag
 - water container
 - small water bottle to refill
 - Synthetic round + mop Brushes (Raphael softaqua 845 + Imit. Kolinski 8345)
 - Acrylic markers with fine tips
 - Fountain pen with waterproof ink
 - A selection of graphite pencils
 - Eraser: dust-free or kneaded eraser
 - Masking tape
 - A selection of colored pencils
- Not in the photo, useful for sketching in the field:
- metal clips
 - plastic board
 - small travel stool

Tools + materials

This small palette resembles a split primary palette, with one warm and cool version of each primary color and a few extras.

This list might help you when deciding on colors for your own palette. You can choose whatever type of watercolor is available to you. I added the pigment numbers so that you can compare across brands.

All colors are listed from top to bottom in vertical columns, starting on the left.

Suggested pigments:

column 1:

- Titanium White PW6
- Winsor Lemon Yellow (PY175)
- Schmincke Raw Sienna (PY42, PY43)

column 2:

- Winsor Yellow (PY154)
- Holbein Isoindolinone Yellow Deep (PY110)
- Schmincke Burnt Sienna (PR101, PBk9)
- Schmincke Green Umber (PBr7)

column 3:

- Schmincke Perylene Maroon (PR 179)
- Schmincke Vermilion (PR255)
- Schmincke Burnt Umber (PBr7)

column 4:

- Schmincke Ruby Red or WN Permanent Rose (PV19)
- Winsor & Newton Sap Green (PG36, PY110)
- Winsor & Newton Cobalt Green (PG50)

column 5:

- Winsor & Newton Cobalt Blue (PB28)
- Schmincke Ultramarine Finest (PB29)

column 6:

- Winsor & Newton Cerulean Blue (PB35)
- Schmincke Delft Blue or Holbein Royal Blue (PB60)
- Schmincke Payne's Gray (PR101, PB29, Pbk7)
